1) Welcome and Roll Call

- a.* Get a head count – please sign in

2) Current Police Department News – Discussion

- a.* Officers patrol car hit on I-70 last week – one hit earlier this year too
- b.* Suspect in KCPD from Independence – long history with us
- c.* Been going out with codes, water pollution control and others for clean ups around city
- d.* Just finished the spring Citizen Academy last week – all who started completed it

3) Annual Registration

- a.* Please complete it if you haven't. Need it each year to be considered an official group – some have been coming in
- b.* Requirements need to be met to get a sign and then maintained
- c.* Neighborhood Watch signs – approximately \$100 - \$125 per additional signs – 5 ordered from sign department so far

4) Current Crime Trends

- a.* Stolen Autos/Theft from Auto
 - i.* Lee's Summit area – thefts from vehicle at Adair Park / Cracker Barrel – some were unlocked vehicles – easy targets
 - ii.* Hotels still have cars stolen from them and having stolen auto dumped there
- b.* Thefts
 - i.* Wire continues to be stolen throughout different parts of city – find insulation at camps and abandoned buildings where it's been stripped
 - ii.* Storage unit thefts around 291 mentioned throughout the month

c. Scams

- i. Still getting reports about people calling or texting – scam messages – do not respond to them – warrants from IPD and they must be paid now
- ii. Suspicious emails – example - PayPal link clicked on it, gave remote access to someone, took \$7200 from them and converted to Bitcoin

d. Abandoned houses/businesses

- i. Went with codes, dangerous buildings, animal control to evict and cleared yard – will be meeting as group to streamline process to make it easier for all groups to get together on these properties
- ii. Please call dispatch to report suspicious activity
- iii. Secure as good as possible – struggle to keep secure because get pulled down
- iv. People will break in to steal copper, wiring or anything they can get hands on
- v. Or looking for a place to stay because of the weather – should start getting better

e. Package Theft

- i. You can go to <https://informedelivery.usps.com/box/pages/intro/start.action> and see every piece of mail you will be getting delivered

5) Neighborhood meetings/block parties

- a. Give plenty of notice on request for officers (3 Weeks Minimum)
- b. Please fill out a form and/or email us with your request
 - i. Include date, time, location, number of people attending, and topic you would like covered (We will do our best to accommodate special displays pending calls for service and special operations)
 - ii. If you're wanting a road blocked, then a Special Permit Application needs to be filled out (45-day notice)
